

Mac Obourn called the regular meeting of the Greenwood County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Other members present were Paul Hodge, Preston Evenson, Roy Ballard, County Counselor Paul Dean and County Clerk Deann McCaffree.

Commissioners led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Road and Bridge Report:

- Emergency Management Director, Levi Vinson informed commissioners that the cost of the 2012 CAT 12m2 grader that was approved for purchase, was not stated in the motion for approval Oct 21, 2024. This is needed in the minutes for the purchase.

Hodge moved to approve the purchase of a 2012 CAT 12m2 grader at \$92,000.00 with trade-in. Evenson seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Road and Bridge received a tire bid from Rock's 54 Tire and Oil LLC. (JE24-96)

Evenson moved to approve the tire bid from Rock's 54 Tire and Oil LLC. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Ballard asked Sheriff, Heath Samuels about a tire machine that had been purchased to fix vehicles at the impound lot. Samuels stated it had been purchased with impound funds and would be beneficial not just for the Sheriff's department but other departments when the county mechanic has time.

Evenson moved to approve a Cereal Malt Beverage license for Hamptons 2.0. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Ballard moved to approve a Cereal Malt Beverage license for Troll King at Tri-Corner. Evenson seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Obourn moved to approve payables in the amount of \$211,234.70. Evenson seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Hodge moved to approve payroll in the amount of \$154,665.64. Evenson seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

County Clerk Deann McCaffree informed commissioner that voting delegates were needed for KCamp.

Ballard moved to appoint Commissioner Mac Obourn as a KCamp voting delegate and Commissioner, Preston Evenson as an alternate. Hodge seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Register of Deeds, Marsha Ramsey questioned commissioners on how spectators could watch the commission meeting. McCaffree believed the zoom link should be public and it was also suggested using YouTube. Commissioners discussed the need for updated audio equipment for the meeting room.

Ballard moved to approve a 10-minute executive session for legal. Hodge seconded. Motion carried 4-3. Reconvened at 9:45. No decisions.

Obourn shared with commissioners an invitation to the Kirkham Micheal 2024 client appreciation dinner, December 3rd, 2024.

Hodge moved to adjourn at 9:47. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 5-0.


