

Commission Chair, Mac Obourn, called the regular meeting of the Greenwood County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Other members present were Roy Ballard, Ron Mast, Judd Everitt, Preston Evenson, County Counselor Paul Dean and County Clerk Deann McCaffree.

Commissioners led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

***Ballard moved to approve March 24, 2025 minutes as written. Evenson seconded. Motion carried 5-0.***

**Road and Bridge Report:**

- Road and Bridge Supervisor Allen Greenwood presented engineer specifications for the “Baker Crossing” open range road cattle guard crossings.
- Greenwood also presented bids for round bottom trailers
- Culverts north of Madison near Huber’s discussion

**Obourn motioned for a Legal Executive Session on roads with Allen Greenwood and Emergency Management director Levi Vinson. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 5-0. Return @ 9:30. No decisions. Obourn motion to extend for 5 minutes Ballard seconded. Return @ 9:37. No decisions**

Review of Treasurer’s financial report.

- Clerk McCaffree presented a price quote for 5 computer towers with Microsoft Office, 4 for Clerk’s office and 1 for computer server room. Average price of \$1,148 each.

**Everitt moved to approve purchase of computer towers. Evenson seconded. Motion carried 5-0.**

***Evenson moved to approve special payables for March 31, 2025 in the amount of \$2155.31. Mast seconded. Motion carried 5-0.***

***Obourn moved to approve payables for April 4, 2025 in the amount of \$132,773.99. Ballard seconded. Motion carried 5-0.***

***Evenson moved to approve payroll for April 4, 2025 in the amount of \$160,778.31. Mast seconded. Motion carried 5-0.***

**Old Business:**

- Luke Westerman – Eureka Fire/Rescue Truck purchase option presentation. Prefer option #1 in the amount of \$42,877.08. City of Eureka will invoice with payment made to the City of Eureka.

**Evenson moved to approve payment using Purchase Option #1 in the amount of \$42,877.08 for the County’s share. Everitt seconded. Motion carried 5-0.**

- Joy Jensen questions on the intersection of 90<sup>th</sup>/Q Rd. Vinson explained reasons for road grid system changes.

**New Business:**

- Frank McCollum – Fall River Dam bridge. **No discussion per legal counsel.**
- Resolution 2025-36 – change to **Corrected 2025-13** as a road was missed in the description.

**Ballard moved to approve Resolution 2025-13(Corrected) version. Evenson seconded. Motion carried 5-0.**

- Resolution 2025-37 Tax Sale

**Ballard moved to approve Resolution 2025-37. Evenson seconded. Motion carried 5-0.**

**Mast moved to have a 5 minute break. Evenson seconded. Motion carried 5-0**

- Noxious Weed interim director asked for a generator for the building to keep chemical from freezing. Commissioners instructed to find out about insulation and a portable generator.
- Vinson ask for a decision of the 4 intersections in question due to road changes.

**Everitt moved to approve to proceed with intersections of 190<sup>th</sup>/N, 150<sup>th</sup>/S, 150/U and 90<sup>th</sup>/Q changes to align with the R/S road designations. Obourn seconded. Motions carried 4-1 with Ballard opposing.**

*Evenson moved to approve a ten-minute executive session with Legal Counsel, Paul Dean and Sheriff Heath Samuels. Obourn seconded. Motion carried 5-0. Return @ 11am. Motion to extend executive for 15 minutes.. Return @ 11:17am. No decisions.*

*Ballard motion for a 10 minute executive with Road Supervisor Greenwood for Contract Negotiations. Evenson seconded. Return @ 11:27am. No decision.*

*Obourn motion for a 15 minute executive session for legal with Counselor Dean, Greenwood, Vinson. Ballard seconded. Return @11:44am. No decisions.*

Ballard made clarification about culverts in township roads in Madison Township. County agreed to repair certain culverts prior to Greenwood becoming Road Supervisor, that was not done. Culverts on X north of 375<sup>th</sup> and old rock culvert north on X and Pedroja bridge on 370<sup>th</sup>. Greenwood will get H and H study for waterflow.

Evenson to work with dept heads on replacement plan for equipment.
